**NOTE:** These letters ought not to be mere "character reference" letters. They should attest to specific contributions you have made, specific activities you have engaged in, specific achievements that have benefited or that show some promise in the future of benefiting your overall leadership capacity. In other words, these letters are primarily for the sake of acquiring outside confirmation that you have really done or achieved what you claim to have done or achieved in your scholarship application. The best letter will describe specific contributions you have made and/or specific observations that your reference has seen that demonstrate the contributions to which s/he is referring.
